PROCLAMATION OF A TOWN STATE OF EMERGENCY

- Pursuant to the Town of Bostic's Civil Emergencies Ordinance, Rutherford County State of Emergency Ordinance and Chapter of North Carolina's General Statutes and Article 36A of Chapter 14 of North Carolina General Statute, I have determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the Town of Bostic's Civil Emergencies Ordinance and Rutherford County's State of Emergency Ordinance does exist in the Town of Bostic because of an imminent threat of widespread or sever damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from a natural weather-related cause due to Storm Izzy which is expected to bring high winds and the accumulation of snow, sleet and ice and temperatures at or below freezing, which will result in power outages, hazardous travel conditions and down trees beginning this 15th day of January, 2022.
- Section 2 I, thereby, proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the Town of Bostic.
- Section 3 I hereby order all County law enforcement officers and employees and all other Emergency Management personnel subject to my control to cooperate in enforcement and implementation of the provision of the County Emergency Ordinance.
- Section 4 County personnel are authorized to establish emergency shelters and to expend necessary Town funds to provide temporary congregate care for Town of Bostic citizens.
- Section 5 County agencies shall work cooperatively to assure the needs of Town of Bostic and its citizens are met to the extent possible with those resources under my control.
- Section 6 **EXECUTION OF EMERGENCY PLAN.** All civilians and emergency management personnel are ordered to comply with Rutherford County's All Hazards, Emergency Operations Plan.
- Section 7 This proclamation shall be in effect immediately from January 15th, 2022 until it is modified or rescinded.
- Section 8 Proclaimed this the 15th day of January 2022 at 5:00 p.m.
